6.1 Discussion of Steering Committee recommendations – D. Myers

- 6.1.1 Close one school - and have configurations PK-5, 6-8, 9-12 ask for Bond to improve the schools and look at expanded Pre-K program to attract new families
- 6.1.2 Close one school - and have configurations PK-4, 5-8, 9-12, ask for Bond to improve the schools and look at expanded Pre-K program to attract new families. This allows for a smaller elementary facility, which will be large under PK-5 and the feedback was somewhat close to option 1.
- 6.1.3 Leave schools as they are today, still look for possible bond issue to improve the schools, limited renovations and spread out over more facilities, expand Pre-K program.
